Pre-Kindergarten Screening & Application Information

We are now accepting applications for the 2024-2025 school year. (Please see the attached flyer.) The pre-kindergarten program is designed to provide services to children with special education needs within an inclusive setting. Peer models are accepted on a limited basis. Our screening is a brief, yet comprehensive, assessment of a child's pre-academic skills to ensure your child is developing skills appropriately. The selection of peers is made by program staff and administrators based upon previously determined criteria and a play-based screening session. Invitations to the play-based screening will be shared with applicants and their families in April. Eligible children must be three years of age by August 31 and cannot turn 5 before September 1st. Please return the completed application along with the Ages and Stages Questionnaire to Center Elementary School by

mailing it to Stephanie Bergan or by dropping it off at the Center School office. **Applications are due by April 3rd.** Applicants will be notified by the end of June if their child was accepted into the program.

New Kindergarten Eligibility Entry Date

Children entering kindergarten must turn 5 years old on or before September 1, 2024 to be eligible for kindergarten in the 2024-2025 school year. This is a change from the previous kindergarten cutoff date of January 1, 2025. Based on the new Connecticut legislation, if your child's 5th birthday falls on September 2, 2024 through August 31, 2025, your child will enter kindergarten in the 2025-2026 school year. If your child is eligible for kindergarten for the 2024-2025 school year, please contact the Center School office as soon as possible at 860-429-9367 or cesregistration@willingtonct.org
